1	Passport valid for at least 3 months beyond the stay in Schengen territory and minimum 2 blank pages and issued within the last 10 years.		
2	1 recent color white background photographs (not more than 6 months ) <b>3.5 cm x 4.5 cm</b>		
3	<b>1 Schengen visa application form</b> completed in blue ink or printed online, duly signed.		
4	Copy of <b>biographical page of current passport + copies of previous Schengen visas, US, UK or Canada, granted in the past three years</b> (if any)		
5	Nationals other than Thailand, Myanmar, Cambodia or Laos, original and copy of work permit/resident permit or long term visa.		
6	Original employment letter (not more than 1 month) or company registration (Business owner) or Original Student Certificate.		
7	<b><u>Minors Traveling alone or only with one of the parents:</u></b> <b>Legalized birth certificate translated</b> if not in English. <b>Travel consent declaration</b> signed at BLS, OR legalized and translated consent travel declaration done at the Amphur.		
8	Original <b>applicant's bank statements</b> for the last 3 months along with <b>original bank certificate</b> . Statements must be stamped and signed by the bank.		
9	<b>Sponsorship letter:</b> If sponsored by direct relatives, a certified letter signed by them and their proof of economic means as per point 6. Other sponsorships will be considered by the Embassy on a case-by-case basis.		
10	<b>Cover letter and/or itinerary</b> explaining the reasons for visiting Spain, trip dates and accommodation for each day, entries and exist from each Schengen country (if visiting others than Spain), indicating amount of days in each country and total amount of days spent in the Schengen area.		

11	Invitation letter, entry tickets, enrolment conditions, detailed program of the sports or cultural event.		
12	Hotel booking/reservation (showing all applicants names). If invited by a resident in Spain: Invitation letter and attested copy of the passport or the DNI or the residence card of the person living in Spain. If staying at own house/apartment, proof of ownership or rental.		
13	Proof of round-trip airplane reservation. Proof of transport within Spain and/or between Schengen countries (bus, train, flight ticket, car rental, etc.). <b>Remark: Fake or cancelled flight booking can entail refusal of the visa</b>		
14	Travel Insurance as per EU guidelines with a minimum coverage of €30,000		

**Important Notes: All documents in Thai must be translated into English, attaching a copy of the Thai original. Please help us save paper and space by presenting your documents printed in both sides and avoiding unnecessary and unrequired information and/or documents such as your Thai ID.**

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This is not an exhaustive list. Applicants can be requested to submit additional documents or can be called at an interview if required by the Embassy.

The visa fees and the BLS Service fees are non-refundable.
